

Memorial Garden

The Zion Lutheran church Memorial Garden is a special place of prayer and meditation to commemorate the lives and faith of our loved ones.

A Short service called and “Interment Service” is performed when the ashes are interred into the Garden and a brief history of the deceased is added to the **Book of Memory** kept at the entrance of Yeager Chapel. In addition, a special brick may be placed in the Garden Courtyard, engraved with the name of the loved one.

The ashes are interred *into* the soil of the Garden in an unmarked space and become a permanent part of the Garden.

In this ever changing world, more and more people are choosing cremation as a form of burial.

The Zion Memorial Garden offers a place of peace and beauty for the final resting place of our loved ones.

The Garden is located on the east side of the church, at the chapel entrance. It is maintained by the Memorial Garden Committee with plantings of flowers and ground cover. To preserve the Master Design for the Garden, no other plantings may be made.

Those wishing to use the Garden for interment must complete a Memorial Garden Agreement, and payment is required at that time. A copy of the agreement is available in the church office.

Gifts to the Memorial Garden may be made for a specific purpose designated by the Memorial Garden Committee, or simply given for the maintenance of the Garden. A copy of the Contributions Agreement is available in the church office.

Regardless of your future plans, contributions for the Garden are gratefully accepted.
